Introduction

For the live coordination, you need an Autodesk 360 account (free) and the BIM 360 Glue iPad App (free). If you already have an Autodesk 360 account, you can use that. If not, click on the following link to create an account:

Once you have created the Autodesk 360 account, please follow these steps:

Step 1: Send me Your Email Address

I will need your email address that you used to create your Autodesk 360 account. I will add that email account to the BIM 360 Glue project and will give you access to the models. Please send me an email at deepak@deepakmaini.com with your email address.

Step 2: Accept the Invitation Email

Once I add you to the BIM 360 Glue project, you will get an email about it on the same email address that you sent me. Accept the invite in that email.

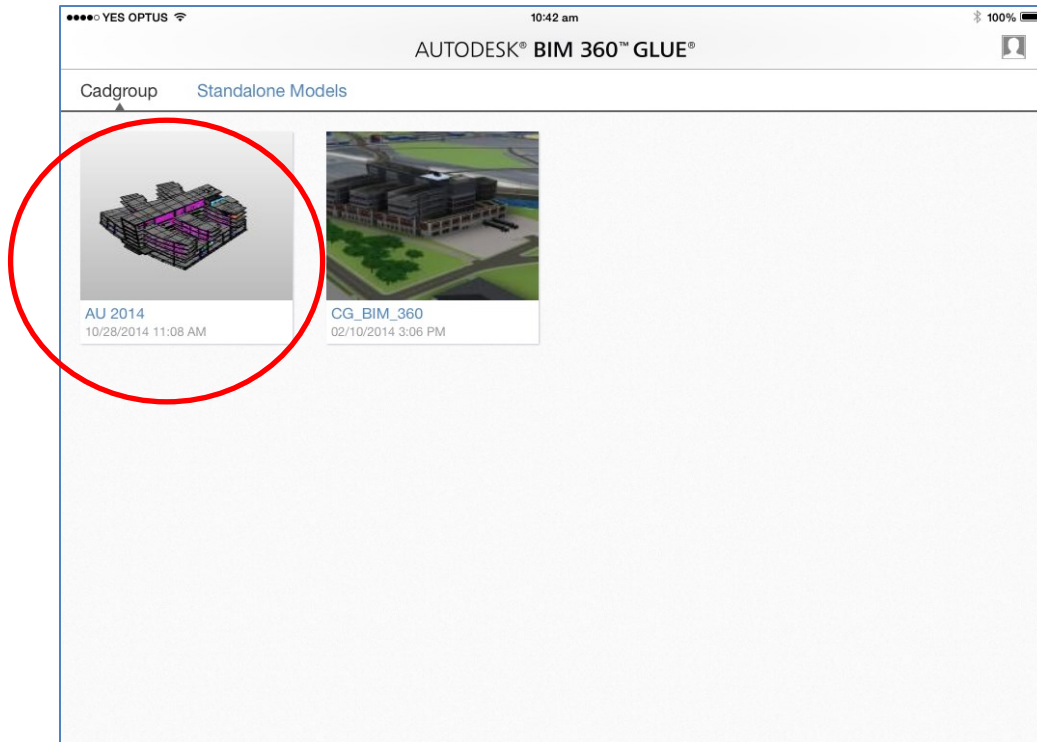
Step 3: Installing BIM 360 Glue App on your iPad (if you don't already have it installed)

1. Go to App Store on your iPad.
2. Search for BIM 360 Glue App.
3. Download and install it. If prompted, login using your iTunes account.
4. Once installed, tap on the BIM 360 Glue App to run it.
5. Login using your Autodesk email address (the one that I used to add you to the project).

Step 4: Downloading the Model on iPad for Offline Use (Only after I add you to the project)

I am planning to finalize adding everyone to the project by the latter half of this week. Once I add you to the project, you will get an email about it. After getting the email, please perform the following steps.

1. In the iPad BIM 360 Glue App, tap on **AU 2014** project, as shown below. You will be taken to the **Merged Models** area.



2. In this area, tap on the “cloud icon” of the **BIMWest** model to download this model for offline use, see below in the image. The model will start to download. Once it is downloaded, you are good to go. We will use this model in live design review in the presentation.
